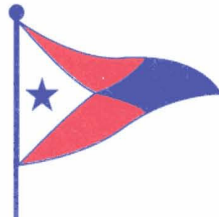

2011 CITY ISLAND YACHT CLUB SUNDAY JAM SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

SUNDAY JUNE 26, 2011 AND SUNDAY JULY 31, 2011

1. The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009 – 2012 and these Sailing Instructions shall govern the series. In case of conflict, these Sailing Instructions control.
2. The start line shall be between an orange or yellow flag displayed on the committee boat, and EBYRA mark “S” in Eastchester Bay, north of 46A.
3. Course: The course shall be from the start to EBYRA mark “A”, then to EBYRA mark “R”, then to EBYRA mark “L”, then to EBYRA mark “A” then to EBYRA mark “R” then to the finish. All marks to be left to starboard. A course chart is enclosed. EBYRA marks are yellow cylinders.

Depending on conditions, the Race Committee may elect to use a short course. If so, an announcement will be made on VHF channel 72 no later than five minutes before the start sequence commences. The short course is: start to EBYRA mark “A”, then to EBYRA mark “R” then to finish. All marks to be left to starboard.

4. All boats will be in division number 1.
5. The start sequence shall be:

Numeral pennant “1” (red dot on a white field) hoisted, one sound, 5 minutes to start.

“P” flag (white square on a blue field) hoisted, one sound, 4 minutes to start

“P” flag lowered, one sound, 1 minute to start

Numeral pennant "1" lowered, one sound, start.

6. The Race Committee will endeavor to announce the starting sequence on Channel 72. All competitors are urged to monitor VHF channel 72. Remember, commercial vessels monitor channel 13 and will use that channel to communicate if necessary.
7. Finish: The finish line is between an orange or yellow flag on the race committee boat and EBYRA mark "S."
8. The race will not be started after 4:30.
9. Any competitor that does not finish the race within 1 hour and 45 minutes from the start will be scored DNF.
10. Scoring will be PHRF, time-on distance.
11. Welcome: There will be soda, chips and beer available at the City Island Yacht Club dock after the race. The race committee will endeavor to announce results at that time. If possible, please moor at your regular mooring and take a launch to the dock. It is high season and guest moorings are booked well in advance.
12. Safety: The safety of each yacht and her crew is the sole responsibility of the yacht's captain/owner. Each yacht and her crew, by participating in this race, agree to do so at their own risk and waive any claim against and hold the City Island Yacht Club, its officers, directors, committee members, employees and agents harmless against any claims arising in any way out of participation in the race by such boat and its crew.
13. The mark positions are as follows. No warranty is made that marks have not drifted from these locations.

Start: N 40 degrees 49.624 minutes
W 73 degrees 47.403 minutes

Mark "A": N 40 degrees 48.894 minutes
W 73 degrees 47.488 minutes

Mark "R": N 40 degrees 49.251 minutes
W 73 degrees 47.936 minutes

Mark "L": N 40 degrees 49.447 minutes
W 73 degrees 47.162 minutes
